On 3/24/14 Hearing officer David Conley appointed. On 4/29/14 issued Pre hearing order with a second PHC scheduled for July 7, 2014 at 9am. 5/15/14 received joint letter from attorneys regarding questions of law and fact.

4/28/14 received withdrawal of appeal. Docket now closed.

Division Activities & Legislative Update:

Vice Chairman Cunningham introduced Wendy Bonner and Mr. John Duclos who gave a presentation on the draft rules on contaminated wipes.

Vice Chairman Cunningham introduced Gary Lynn, MTBE Bureau of the Waste Management Division.

Mr. Lynn gave a presentation overview of the MTBE Bureau of the Waste Management Division. Mr. Lynn explained what MTBE is and what its properties are. He also explained why it is a problem and that there are over 600 known MTBE sites. He also explained there budget and the types of eligible activities.

Vice Chairman Cunningham introduced Michael Wimsatt, Waste Management Division Director.

Mr. Wimsatt Welcomed Mr. Rudy Bazelmans to the Council Mr. Wimsatt went over the hiring of the four key staff for the MTBE Bureau. Gary Lynn Administrator. Dereck Bennett Drinking Water Quality Administrator III, Tal Hubbard, Remedial Action Civil Engineer VI, and Josh Whipple Site Investigation Hydrogeologist V. He also went over the hiring of some of the positions in the HWRB. Robin Mongeon is now the Administrator of the Federal sites section & superfunds sites. Fred McGarry is now working part time on the Liberty Hill site in Gilford. Tim Noury is now working in plan review for AST and UST section. Ralph Wickson retired as well as Harry Stewart the director of the Water Division. They have appointed a new Director Mr. Gene Forbes. He also gave a brief synopsis of HB 1151 Solid Waste operator training and financial assurance they passed the house but hit a speed bump in the senate. HB 1224 Pipeline Transport of Crude oil passed and awaits governor signature. HB 1344 Retail Pharmaceutical sharps have gone to interim study. HB 1570 Paint stewardship failed in the Senate in spite of everyone's hard work.
