Call to Order:

Chairman Bazelmans called the meeting to order at 10:04 AM, verifying that a quorum was present.

Approval of Minutes:

Duncan Watson made the motion to accept the June 19, 2014 minutes, Steve Crean seconded. All in were in favor

Status of Appeals:

There was no Status Appeal

Division Activities & Legislative Update:

Chairman Bazelman introduced Ms. Karlee Kenison and Mr. Michael McCluskey who presented the draft rules on Env-Or 600 Contaminated Site Management, Env-Or 700 Groundwater Release Detection Permits and Env-800 Brownfields Program Under RSA -147-F. The Council had some Objections to the Rules. Nancy Kinner made a motion to write a letter of concern to DES about the 600 Contaminated Site Management Rules. Arthur Cunningham Amended the motion to include the conflict with 70302C. Mike Durfor seconded all were in favor except Steve Crean, Who objected.

Chairman Bazelmans introduced Michael Wimsatt, Waste Management Division Director. Mr. Wimsatt gave a brief synopsis of the Fall Spill Drill. There was a release of # 6 Oil from Sprague; there were 5 Agencies and over 200 participants, including the State of Maine. There was also a reporter from NHPR who did a report on the Spill. There have been some staff changes within the Division. In the ORCB Bureau Peg Bastien replaced Gary Lynn, Laura Weit - Malcomb is our new enforcement specialist. Chuck Corilis has accepted the position in the UST and AST Bureau in Technical Standards & Design Review. Mr. Greg Kirby who worked in our Gorham office has retired. Peter Sandin is now working in our Pease office on the Department of Defense sites. Tim Denison will be retiring in December. Judy Houston has left the Solid Waste Bureau which leaves a vacancy that will require a waiver. Lots of work has been done on the Haven Hill wells but they are still closed. There have been 25 private wells that have been tested. Our Hazardous Waste Compliance Bureau has finally moved down to the first floor. There have been numerous meetings regarding Ebola with Dr. Montero heading up the efforts to make sure that we will ready for any issues that may arise. The meetings have addressed Waste water issues and infectious waste storage and how these issues would be handled. Mr. Wimsatt also addressed the issue of Flow Control.
