2020- 2021 Budget is due to the Governor's office by September 1, proposed budget to governor by Valentine's Day. The Governor will then present the budget.

The Drinking Water and Ground Water trust fund advisory Commission meet yesterday, to discuss and review applications. Next Commission meeting will be on August 30.

There was a significant Spill of H6 fuel at the Mount Washington Hotel. The Dartmouth Brook was boomed, they have removed the Boiler in the Boiler room. This is an ongoing investigation and cleanup will be ongoing for some time.

Mr. Wimsatt introduced Lea Anne Atwell. Lea Anne is in charge of Hazardous Waste Remediation Emerging Contaminates Section. Lea Anne gave a summary on PFOA and PFOS and their complexity and their effects on the environment. She also gave the Council information on the New Water lines that are supplying water to the homes that have had their water contaminated in Londonderry. DES has sampled over 430 sites. They are looking at studies of what the effects are on pregnant woman and children; they are also looking into new Legislation.
